Background:

The Eradicate Hate Global Summit initiative grew from the deadliest anti-Semitic attack in U.S. history. In October 2018, a heavily armed gunman massacred worshippers from three different congregations at Pittsburgh's Tree of Life Synagogue. The attack shocked the world. But unfortunately, it was not an isolated event. Hate continues to grow, becoming the lifeblood of global extremism.

This tragedy continues to energize the organizers to develop the world's most effectively coordinated offensive against hate and extremism.

Purpose of the Eradicate Hate Global Summit:

The Summit will continue to discover effective strategies to globally eradicate violent acts spawned by hate. This year's agenda will emphasize the magnitude of our vision and will feature an extraordinary group of experts that will address the critical issues forming the foundation for extremist hate.

Grounded in the rule of law, the Summit will continue to bring together experts from government, academia, law, the non-profit sector, corporations, and journalism; all converging in Pittsburgh, where the search for effective on-going solutions to global extremism will resume.
